Attorney General Lawrence Wasden has announced investigators with his Idaho Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Unit made two arrests last week in eastern Idaho. A detective from the Caldwell Police Department proudly serves on this statewide task force. The Attorney General's ICAC Unit works with the Idaho ICAC Task Force, a coalition of federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies, to investigate and prosecute individuals who use the internet to criminally exploit children.

On December 13, investigators arrested an Idaho Falls man for alleged sexual exploitation of a child and video voyeurism. 48-year-old Nathan M. Law was booked into the Bonneville County Jail. He is alleged to have possessed and produced sexually exploitative material.

On December 15, 24-year-old Talon C. Beattie was arrested in Pocatello for alleged sexual exploitation of a child. Beattie, of Pocatello, was booked into the Bannock County Jail following his arrest.
