UPDATE: Detectives have determined a person of interest in this case named Gabriel. Caldwell Police ask that if you know this individual to call 343-COPS or non-emergency dispatch at 454-7531.



ORIGINAL RELEASE: Caldwell Police are looking for a man after an early morning shooting. It happened in the 3100 block of Village Green Street at approximately 7:45 this morning. The suspect, who is known to the victim, got into a verbal altercation with the victim, at which point the suspect shot the victim with a firearm.

After the shooting, the suspect fled the scene, in an unknown direction. This appears to be an isolated incident and police do not believe there is a threat to the community at this time. The victim was taken to a local hospital and is in critical condition.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male in his 20's. The shooting is not believed to be gang-related. Anyone with any information is asked to call 343-COPS or non-emergency dispatch at 454-7531.
