Caldwell Police are looking for the suspects responsible for a drive-by shooting. Last night at 10:30 p.m., officers responded to an address in the 100 block of E. Elgin Street after receiving a call that shots were fired. Officers arrived and located multiple fired cartridge casings on Boise Avenue just west of the home which was believed to be the intended target of the violence.

There were no shooting victims located at the scene or inside the home and nothing appeared to be struck by gunfire. During the preliminary investigation, officers recovered evidence and spoke to witnesses at the crime scene. Based on leads identified, officers from the newly formed Operation Safe Streets unit (OSS) responded and conducted a follow-up investigation due to the gang related nature of the incident.
