The Caldwell Police Department is currently investigating two gang-related drive-by shootings that occurred last night. The first shooting targeted a residence on Berkley Avenue at 9:30 p.m. No persons were harmed or injured, but there was visible damage to the residence.

About 30 minutes after the first shooting, officers responded to 2nd Avenue and Elgin Street for the second shooting incident. Officers made contact with a victim who said they were driving and noticed a car following them. The victim pulled over, and the suspect car pulled next to the victim's vehicle and shot several times. The victim was not hit, and the suspect vehicle fled the area.

The shootings are considered gang-related and are under investigation at this time by Operation Safe Streets and our Criminal Investigation Division.

“There is no place for violence in our city and I am confident that our investigators will find the cowards responsible and bring them to justice,” said Rex Ingram, Caldwell Chief of Police.
