Caldwell Police are investigating after responding to a large fight at Brother's Park on Indiana Avenue today just after 3:30 p.m. The fight appears to be gang related and involved 15-20 juveniles. As officers began to arrive the juveniles attempted to leave the park but only made it a short distance before being stopped by incoming units. One of the teens attempted to hide a firearm, but it was quickly discovered.

No one was injured as a result of the fight and no shots were fired.

Four teens were arrested, the others were released to their parents. Detectives are continuing to investigate this incident and others may be charged.

“I am happy that our officers responded swiftly and took immediate action prior to further acts of violence occurring. This should be a stark reminder to parents to be actively involved in the lives of their children, and raise them to understand consequences,” said Rex Ingram, Caldwell Chief of Police.

All individuals are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
