These are your opportunities to dispose of household items for FREE! Call 208-345-1265 or email csidaho@republicservices.com to schedule items too large for your cart. Place items at the curb on your regular service day by 6 am, and follow these guidelines:

Accepted: Tied Bundles (carpet/branches), 4' or shorter, 60 lbs. or less
Large Paper Bags (grass clippings and yard debris)
Non-Freon Appliances/ Furniture/ Large Household Items

NOT Accepted: Liquid Waste/ Hazardous Waste/ Tires/ Freon Appliances

FREE Hazardous Waste Collection Events:

March 9, 2024—Ford Idaho Center 10 am—4 pm

June 12, 2024—O'Connor Fieldhouse 10 am—4 pm

September 14, 2024—Ford Idaho Center 10 am—4 pm

Accepted: Yard Chemicals/ Pool Chemicals/ Solvents/ Paint and Paint Thinner/ Fluorescent Lights/ Automotive Chemicals/ Batteries/ Propane Tanks/ Electronic Waste

NOT Accepted: Explosives/ Radioactive Waste/ Biological Waste/ Ammunition/ Medications/ Tires/ Sharps

Trash Rates

Residential solid waste rates in Caldwell are determined by the TRASH cart size.

- Three trash cart sizes are available: 48-gallon, 65-gallon and 95-gallon.
- Starting April 1, 2024, trash must be contained in contractor-provided trash carts, except during the spring and post-holiday cleanup weeks.
- Extra trash carts are available for a small monthly fee.
- Do not pack the trash so tightly in the cart that it becomes stuck and will not empty.
- When considering the right size cart for your house, think of fall leaves, branches, yard waste, holidays and other peak waste seasons.
- If ordering multiple carts, the 95-gallon rate will apply.
- Lower Senior and Veteran rates are available. Call Caldwell Utility Billing at 208-455-3000, ext. 1 to request a 65-gallon or 48-gallon trash cart, or to sign up for a Senior/Veteran rate.

Recycling

Recycling carts are available in 48-gallon, 65-gallon, and 95-gallon sizes.

- Recycling is collected every-other-week on your regular service day.
- Visit republicservices.com/schedule to identify your next collection dates.
- Extra recycling carts are available for a small monthly fee.
- Accepted Recyclable Materials: Mixed Waste Paper, Flattened Cardboard, Tin and Aluminum Cans, and Rigid Plastic Bottles and Jugs (#1 and #2)
- NOT Accepted in Recycling Cart: Plastic Bags, Glass, Hazardous Waste, Polystyrene Foam, Cartons
