CALDWELL POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESS RELEASE

March 20, 2024

Tonight at 7 p.m., police responded to multiple 911 calls in reference to a shooting in the 1700 block of Cleveland Boulevard. Upon arrival, officers located expended bullet casings. At this time, it does not appear that a person was struck by gunfire and the possible victim fled the scene prior to police arrival.

The suspect is described as a short, Hispanic male, wearing a gray shirt with a short beard. He was last seen driving a gray Chrysler with large wheels.

This appears to be an isolated incident and there is no credible threat to the community at this time. Based on preliminary information it appears gang and narcotics related.
