## Harry E. McCluskey Mayor 1941-1942



Mr. McCluskey was born in Yale, Kansas. His family moved to Idaho and homesteaded in the Sunny Slope community south of Caldwell where he finished his formal education after the eighth grade.

Started his business career with Swift & Co. He later went into business for himself, owning and operating many types of businesses, including the horse and wagon stage and mail route to Jordan Valley. He also owned and operated the H.J. McNeel Lumber Yard in Caldwell.

He was a member of Boone Memorial Presbyterian Church. He was a 50-year member of the Caldwell I00F Lodge and a life member of Caldwell Elks Lodge No. 1448.

He served as Mayor of Caldwell for one-year, 1941-1942.
