Fred Lilly Mayor 1918 and Mayor 1931-1932



Mr. Lilly was elected Mayor of Caldwell at the election of April 1917. He served one-year term as Mayor in 1918 and was re-elected and served a two-year term as Mayor from 1931-1932.

In August of 1915, Mr. Lilly purchased two lots on Kimball where he planned to build a residence.

As the Treasurer for the Salvation Army and along with the Elks' guidance, he formed a campaign to raise money. A Salvation Army drive was conducted and raised a total of \$3,003.57.

He was Manager of Idaho Seed Company and was President of the local Twilight League baseball team.

He served as Mayor of Caldwell for one-year in 1918 and again served two-years in 1931-1932.
