**APPROVE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEDICATION AND NAMING OF SISTERS PARK.**

**WHEREAS**, Mary Crookham was instrumental in the development of Brothers Park and cherished the ability of watching all the youth activities conducted at the park and seeing the trees thrive that the family planted at the site; and

**WHEREAS**, there were other "sisters" that came before Mary and these women also left their footprint in their beloved community of Caldwell, Idaho; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been requested in an effort to recognize and honor Mary Crookham, Bernice Robinson Crookham, Edith Crookham McClain, Judy Crookham, Krueger, and Norine Carlson Crookham, to dedicate the name the fifteen-acre addition to Brothers Park in their behalf;
