A fire that ignited on September 12 was caused due to a vehicle recall that was never repaired. The call came in at 5:45 a.m. in the 2000 block of Strayhorn Drive. The fire started in the vehicle and then spread to the home, engulfing the garage and the upper living quarters of the residence.

Everyone got out of the home safely. No one was injured.
