
I certify that this data is in compliance with requirements under 40 CFR §136 and other analytical requirements specified in NPDES permit ID0021504.

WETT testing for the second quarter was conducted in April. Therefore all subsequent results obtained by standard methods are included in their respective categories on this, the April DMR. The WETT testing results for the second quarter will be submitted in June DMR.

Due to the NETDMR-CDX migration the DMR will be submitted past the due date of the 20th day of the month.

Following an email conversation with Maria Lopez December 20, 2016, we used the 1985 EPA *NPDES Self-Monitoring System User Guide* as a guide for performing our DMR calculations per her suggestion, with the exception of following the 22nd Edition *Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater* rules for rounding and significant figures (SM 1050).
